Objective:

Art is Color

Explore the color wheel by creating secondary colors out of primary colors.

Why?

- Promote gross / fine motor control: movement of arms and hands to scrape and mix colors (infants: to squeeze, poke and push play dough)
- Practice science skills of cause and effect
- Sensory Play: Experimentation and exploration promote curiosity and creativity.
- Introduce or better understand colors and how they interact

This Week:


What We Did:

- Starting with two primary colors we used cardboard to scrape / mix paint into secondary colors.
- Infants = played with and mixed two primary colors of play-dough to create a secondary color.

Terms:

Primary Colors: Red, Yellow and Blue; a group of colors that make secondary colors.

Secondary Colors: Orange, Purple and Green; the color made from two primary colors
