Objective:

- **Art is Color**

Explore the color wheel by creating secondary colors out of primary colors.

Why?

- Promote gross / fine motor control : movement of arms and hands to scrape and mix colors (infants : to squeeze, poke and push play dough)
- Practice science skills of cause and effect
- Sensory Play : Experimentation and exploration promote curiosity and creativity.
- Introduce or better understand colors and how they interact

This Week:

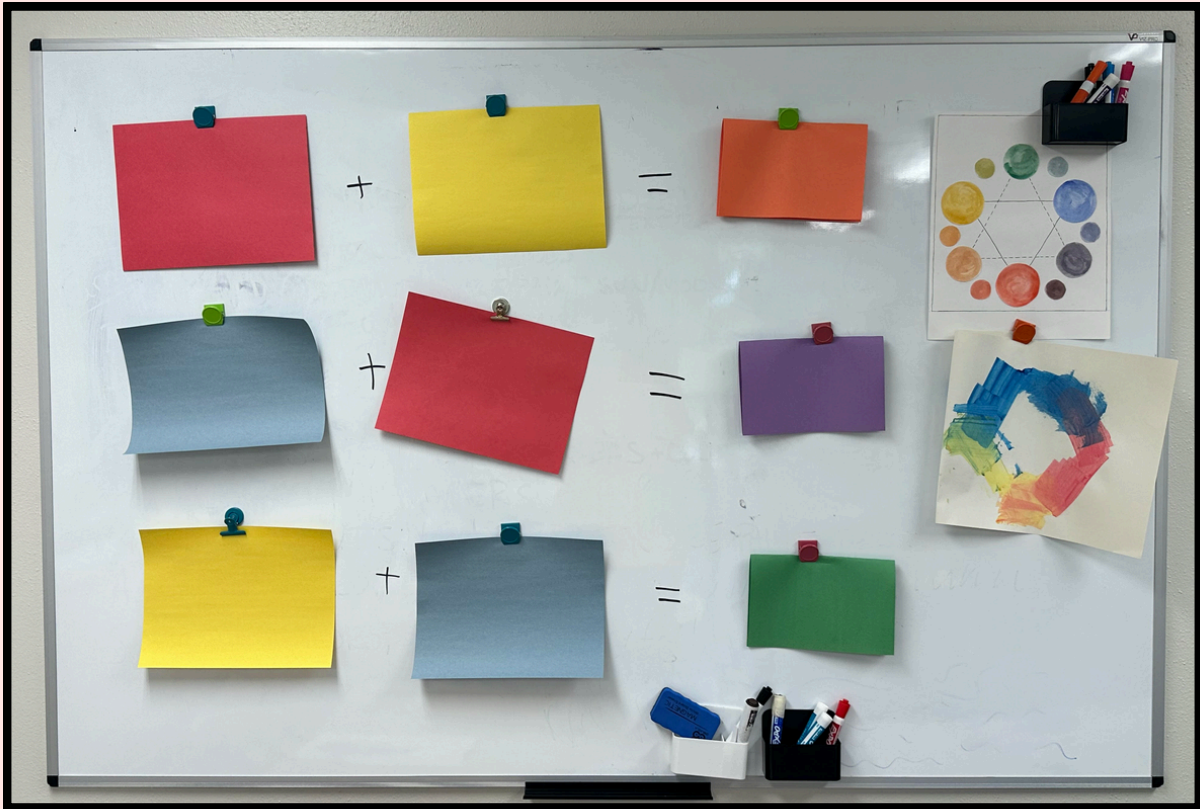
What We Did :

- Starting with two *primary colors* we used cardboard to scrape / mix paint into *secondary colors*.
- Infants = played with and mixed two *primary colors* of play-dough to create a *secondary color*.

Terms:

Primary Colors : Red, Yellow and Blue ; a group of colors that make secondary colors.

Secondary Colors : Orange, Purple and Green ; the color made from two primary colors
